Background

Community Support Services, Inc. (CSS) was founded in 1994 and began its mission by working collaboratively with individuals, families, and other lead agencies to design and implement new models of service.

Over 150 adults are currently receiving Meaningful Day Services through CSS. This includes adults receiving services through Community Living and living at a family residence.

The licensed day habilitation location is in Gaithersburg on Comprint Court and serves as a community resource center throughout the day. The majority of time is spent in community locations depending on the person's plan and choices.

CSS provides a wide range of comprehensive services and has well-trained staff. We have the expertise to develop service plans for people with intensive needs, and also to provide individualized supports for others who have employment and social goals.

Settings

Individuals typically choose part time paid or volunteer work experiences in local businesses, nonprofit organizations, community centers, or religious facilities. Community opportunities include both paid and unpaid work.

At a Glance

Program Schedule

9am-3pm, Monday through Friday

*Work experiences, social/recreation/leisure activities in community settings, structured groups/classes in community venues or in CSS operated facilities.

*The meaningful day service schedule primarily falls between the hours of 8am and 5pm. The service day is individualized based on needs and supports.

*Transportation is coordinated and arranged typically within a ten-mile distance from Comprint Court, Gaithersburg.

*We operate 365 days per year, with individual schedules varying depending on their services.

Staffing Ratio

Staffing ratio is determined by the person's team and approved by DDA. Typically, most individuals receive services with a 1:1, 1:2 or 1:3 staff to individual ratio.

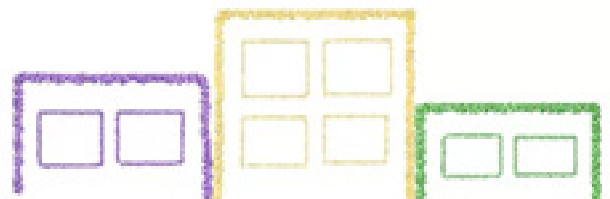
Staff are in compliance with all required DDA training and also receive additional training developed by Community Support Services to best support the needs of the individuals served.

Support staff receive emergency medical training as required by DDA.

Admissions
